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1 INTRODUCTION

2 WHAT ARE COOKIES ?

Cookies are small text files stored on your computer, tablet or mobile device when you visit a website.

Cookies cannot directly identify you, but some may become personal data when combined with other information.

3 TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

3.1 STRICTLY NECESSARY COOKIES

These cookies are essential for the website to function correctly.

They enable features such as:

- Website security
- Page navigation
- Form submission
- Session management
- Load balancing

These cookies cannot be disabled through our cookie banner because they are required for the operation of the website.

3.2 ANALYTICS COOKIES

We use Google Analytics 4 to understand how visitors use our website.

These cookies help us measure:

- Numbers of visitors
- Pages visited
- Time spent on pages
- Traffic sources
- Device types
- General geographic location (country/region)



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The information collected is aggregated wherever possible and is used solely to improve our website.

Analytics cookies are only placed after you have provided consent where required by law.

3.3 FUNCTIONAL COOKIES

Functional cookies remember choices you make to improve your browsing experience, such as language preferences or other website settings.

4 COOKIES WE USE
